For we have come to share in Christ, if indeed we hold our original confidence firm to the end. As it is said, ‘Today, if you hear His voice, do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion.’ For good news came to us as to them, but the message they heard did not benefit them, because they were not united by faith with those who listened.”

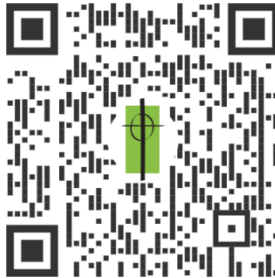
